

The Hunger Strike Book

This is a translated transcript of the notebook from the hunger strike, the text is written “as is” and trying to capture and convey the spirit of hand written text.

The notebook was at the hunger strike from day 4, and people where invited to write their thoughts and feelings...

Israel is a country of organised crime, wealth is connected to the corrupt ruling government, that is indifferent to the little civilian, and only the tycoons and politicians rule the top and run our life according to their interest.

Since the establishment of the state called Israel, burdened with a serious financial crime - robbery of concentration camp survivors, that underwent all the torments of hell.

from smoking logs to muselmans that came out from hell and came to the country in hopes of finding a promising place to rebuild their lives, they found a sealed country that bullied them, stole their money and in no small sense speed up their death, in neglect of medical care after hand.

My mother Bora Wachtel R.I.P. stayed in the country from 1968 until her death 16.05.1987, she was an inmate of the concentration camps of forced labor Częstochowa, & Skarżysko-Kamienna, she left there in wrecks (walking with a stick 40km) and suffered a nervous breakdown; As a result became sick in a mental illness that never healed, with her coming to Israel in July 1968 was admitted to the mental hospital for the rest of her life.

The State of Israel was her Guardian, but instead of worrying about compensation and rehabilitation of her life to the extent possible, was stealing her money and hasten her death; As it did to many of the survivors, and especially the disabled sons. Due to this fact I grew up as an orphan.

Kleiman Adam her only son.

I am a capitalist. To stone me. I Believe that each of us should have a Drive, a target and incentive to get for himself and from himself as much as possible.

So why do I connect to social protests like this hunger strike below my office? That method is screwed.

The numbers don't work out. its impossible to buy a house. Even the wise and talented, do not earn enough in relation to the cost of living and housing.

Because it is not a free market. The State is dealing in lands at the public's expense. In such market the capitalism doesn't work. Because the political system requires a bribe to sectors that are milking the working public.

Why am I here? Because at the end, even if I'm rich and happy, I can not and do not want to live in a place that anywhere around me all embittered. friends are leaving abroad because there you can exist without asking for help from your parents.

If we think practical - there is a situation, and if the situation does not change, there will be a coup and then the people in my class will find themselves helpless.

How long can we take it? One day it will explode.

And perhaps its the only way.

Let's hope for the best.
